Apply for a Committee

The subscriptions for all the committees named before are open now! Do you want to enrich your skills and capabilities? Take action and apply for one of our amazing committees this January! This is how it works:

Step 1: Application

The subscriptions for the committees in January are open on our website, www.faector.nl. Fill in the form and upload your CV (and motivation letter if applicable) to apply before **Friday 19 January 23:58**.

Step 2: Interview

If your application and CV (and motivation letter if applicable) are sufficient, we will invite you for an interview at the FAECTOR office.

Step 3: Committee Announcements

When all interviews have been finished, we will announce the committees shortly after.

Step 1: Apply

First, apply for a committee on our website and upload your CV (& motivation letter if applicable).

Step 2: Interview

If your application is sufficient, we will invite you for an interview.

Step 3: Announcement

After all the interviews have been taken, the new committee members will be announced.

Econometric Career Days Committee



Do you want to organise the biggest multi-day career event for econometricians in the Netherlands? The Econometric Career Days (ECD) connects highly motivated Econometrics & Operations Research students from Erasmus University Rotterdam with prestigious companies. During the 11th edition 47 different companies participated in various events, like cases, presentations and dinners.

Do you think this committee might be something for you? Check out the following information about the various positions available within the ECD committee.

Chairman (🇳🇱):

The chairman is responsible for the general well-being of the ECD and the committee. They are the one leading the weekly meetings and keeps an overview of all the tasks. Furthermore, they are responsible for the Field Trip.

Secretary (🇳🇱):

The secretary is the connection between the students and the ECD and handles all questions coming in from all other parties.

Treasurer (🇳🇱/🇬🇧):

The treasurer is responsible for making and managing the budget for the next ECD.

External Officer (🇳🇱):

This position gives you the opportunity to get in contact with a lot of prestigious companies and great speakers, as it is your responsibility that they participate in the ECD 2024.

Marketing Officer (🇳🇱/🇬🇧):

Your main tasks as one of the marketing officers will be developing a promotion plan, designing, making students aware of the event and establishing a good image of the ECD. The marketing officers will order all the necessary merchandise and make sure that the ECD is represented on the campus

of the Erasmus University. Next to that, you make sure that the social media channels and the website of the ECD are kept up to date.

Day Coordinator :

As the day coordinator you have to make sure that the next ECD will run smoothly. Hereby you can think on such tasks as arranging the locations and catering as well as making detailed day plans. Next to that, you will be responsible for organising the ECD Talks.

When the interviews for the ECD committee are done, we will allocate the different positions over the six selected committee members based on your preferences and your qualities.

Who are we looking for?

We are looking for students in their Bachelor 2+ or (pre)-Master or study phase who are very driven, motivated and social. Besides that, we like to see that you have affinity with the business community and companies in relevant econometric fields. Landelijke Econometristen Dag (LED) 2025 Committee

As a member of the LED 2025 committee, you will organise the yearly National Econometricians Day (in Dutch: Landelijke Econometristendag, abbreviated as LED). This is the largest annual recruitment event for students in the fields of econometrics, operations research, data science, and actuarial sciences in the world. On this day, over 750 students get the opportunity to get in contact with their potential future employers.

The LED is an event of the National Institute of Study

associations for Econometrics (in Dutch: Landelijke Orgaan der Econometrische Studieverenigingen, abbreviated as LOES). The LOES consists of the six study associations for econometrics in the Netherlands: Each year, the LED is organised by members of one of these study associations. This means that this committee only opens up in Rotterdam once every 5 years!

Are you interested in this rare opportunity? Check out the following information about the various positions available within

the LED 2025 Committee.

Chairman

The chairman oversees the committee and event. He or she keeps track of all the tasks and leads the weekly meetings.

Secretary

The secretary is the primary contact of all the students attending the LED. He or she also addresses all inquiries from other parties.

Treasurer

The treasurer makes and

manages the budget for the LED 2025.

External Officer

The external is responsible for acquiring all the companies joining the LED. You are the primary contact for these companies.

Marketing Officer

The marketing officer's role involves crafting all promotional materials and formulating a comprehensive promotion plan to ensure widespread awareness of LED 2025 among students.

Day Coordinator

The day coordinator ensures that the day of the event goes well. He or she coordinates the location, the food etc. The day coordinator knows everything

about what happens during the event.

We will allocate the different positions over the six selected committee members based on your preferences and your qualities. **Note that you need to be fluent in Dutch for all of the positions.**

Who are we looking for?

We are looking for students in their Bachelor 3+ or (pre)-Master who are driven, motivated and social. Besides that, we like to see that you have affinity with the business community and companies in relevant econometric fields. This is an intensive committee that requires a lot of time and commitment. To apply, we ask you to hand in a motivation letter with your application.
