Excellence Programme Committee

Furthermore, you'll handle all the contact with professors and companies giving guest lectures or hosting company visits. Step 1: Apply

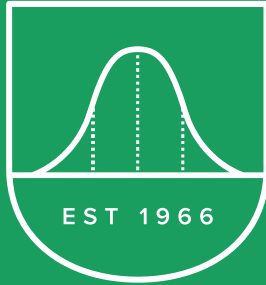
